Dear Prospective LIT/B-LIT:

Thank you for your interest in participating in our Lifeguard-In-Training (LIT) Program/Beginner Lifeguard-In-Training (B-LIT) Program during our 2026 summer season.

The **deadline** for **all** required documents and a guaranteed spot in the program is **May 1, 2026**. However, we will take applications until the start of the program if there are spots available. The following documents are to be submitted via email to Taylor@lbtbp.com or dropped off/mailed to Town Hall:

1. Application – completed in full
2. Physician's Document (School Sports physical is **not** acceptable)– needed for swim test/participation in program
3. Birth Certificate (for new applicants)

Each applicant must pass our swim test, taken at St. Francis Aquatic Center (schedule is attached). The requirements are as follows:

LIT -	150 yards in 2:30 or less
B-LIT -	150 yards in 3:00 or less.

You will be notified, **at the swim test**, if you have been accepted into the LIT or B-LIT Program by the Program Director.

The fees for the LIT/B-LIT Program this summer are as follows and payable **only upon** notification of acceptance:

LIT Program -	\$ 375.00
B-LIT Program -	\$ 150.00

**(Do not send payment with application.
This fee is due only upon your notified acceptance into the LIT/B-LIT Program.)**

B-LIT and LIT is one (1) six (6) week session from **Monday, June 29th through Friday, August 7th**.

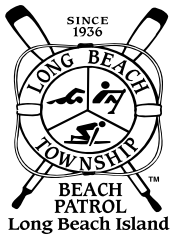

2026 LBTBP Lifeguard-In-Training and Beginner Lifeguard-In-Training (LIT/B-LIT) Programs

Objectives

The following skills and goals will be met through practical and objective application as guided by the instructors.

- To enable young men and women to become familiar with and knowledgeable about the profession of lifeguarding.
- To improve physical, mental, and social skills while developing maturity.
- To give each individual the ability to safely enjoy our surrounding water environment.
- To learn the ocean rescue techniques used by LBTBP.
- To educate individuals about ocean safety and LBTBP policies.

Class Times and Dates

LIT class will begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 12:00 noon, Monday through Friday.

B-LIT class will begin at 1:30 p.m. and end at 3:30 p.m., on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

There will be optional skill sessions Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. for those who want or need additional skill instruction, as determined by the LBTBP LIT Program instructors.

Classes meet at Bayview Park, 68th St., on the Bay in Brant Beach.

For **2026**, the Program dates will be:

Swim Test

A swim test will be held in the indoor pool at the St. Francis Center. The test consists of a 150-yard swim (6 lengths) that must be passed in 2:30 minutes or less for LITs and 3:00 minutes or less for B-LITs. Candidates may take the swim test up to two (2) times in order to improve their swim test times. You must attend one of the swim test dates below. Physicians Document must be submitted prior to, or on the day of, the swim test to be permitted to take the swim test.

Arrangements have been made to use the St. Francis Pool for pre-season training. Beginning April 1st - Monday, Wednesday and Friday 4 p.m. - 6:00 p.m., Tuesday and Thursday 7 a.m. - 9 a.m., and Sunday 3 p.m. - 5 p.m. Lifeguards/LITs/B-LITs may use the pool to train for their swim test. Enter at the main Aquatic Center door, sign in and respect all pool rules. LBTBP application must be received to take part in the pre-test/pre-season pool training. These times are specifically for training for the swim tests. Please do not bring friends/siblings, not training for the test, to use the pool during these times.

Program Requirements

- LIT applicants must be 13 - 15 years of age at the start of the session. B-LITs must be 10 - 12 years of age at the start of the session.
- **Applications will not be accepted unless accompanied by the applicant's birth certificate and completed physicians form. School sports physicals are not acceptable.**
- Uniforms will be provided and must be worn during the LIT Program.
- Applications are requested to be submitted by May 1, 2026, but will be accepted until the start of the program if spots are available.
- Priority for sessions will be given to returning LITs. Admission in the program is on a first-come, first-serve basis provided the applicant passes the swim test.
- Participants of the LIT program will be charged a fee of \$375.00 and participants of the B-LIT program will be charged a fee of \$150.00. **This fee is due only upon your acceptance into the LIT/B-LIT Program.** Further questions may be directed to the LIT Program Director or Tracey A.
